

## **TU9 at the 21st European Career Fair in Boston (US)**

### **Alliance of Leading Universities of Technology in Germany takes part in Europe's biggest recruitment fair at Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT)**

**Berlin, March 3, 2017** – TU9 was represented at the European Career Fair (ECF) in Boston (US) for the tenth consecutive year. From February 25 to 27, more than 100 educational institutes, companies and non-profit organizations were on hand at Massachusetts Institute of Technology to inform this year's fairgoers about career opportunities in German research.

TU9, the Alliance of leading Universities of Technology in Germany, was represented by four member universities, each with their own booths: TWTH Aachen University, Karlsruhe Institute of Technology, Technical University of Munich, and University of Stuttgart. With TU9 Managing Director Dr. Nicole Saverschek also in attendance, TU9 used the fair to recruit international (early career) researchers for STEM subjects.

The European Career Fair is the biggest European recruitment fair held in the US. International graduates attend the fair to explore opportunities for doctoral studies and research positions. There, they meet with employers from science and industry, and can ask for advice regarding current vacancies and opportunities for funding.

In addition to their own booths on the day of the fair, the TU9 Universities also participated in the "Research in Germany" workshop for early career researchers during which a roundtable format was used to inform interested candidates about career paths in Germany.

On the final evening, a GAIN/GSO networking event was held at the Goethe Institute.

### **The MIT European Career Fair**

Each year, over 3,000 visitors attend the informative career fair, most of them young graduates and researchers from elite universities in the US. Many are Germans who are in the US for study purposes or as members of research project teams, and are interested in returning to Germany.
