

One-Click Open Access Publications from TU9 Universities

New service offered by TU9 libraries: Search engines for all open access publications stored at the nine Alliance locations

Berlin, February 1, 2018 - A joint search function on the TU9 website makes it possible to search across all open access publications from TU9 universities simultaneously.

Publication management is becoming increasingly important at universities in the digital age. Publications must be easily findable (including in a targeted search), accessible and, where possible, interoperable and reusable. For scientific publications that are freely available as open access, many university sites have set up open-access repositories that can be used to search for and display publications.

The TU9 libraries have now joined forces and from February 1, 2018, will make their open access publications jointly searchable via the TU9 website using a one-click search function (<https://www.tu9.de/forschung/>).

Using the Base search engine, the architecture set up in cooperation with Bielefeld University Library and the Technical Information Library provides a TU9-filtered list of results. The search set can be narrowed by using filters such as “location” or “year”. Once found, a publication can then be selected by clicking on the corresponding link.
